Audit Contract and Engagement Letter for FY 2015-16. He recommended approval of the contract with Carr, Riggs, & Ingram to perform the audit for fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 at a cost of \$47,000 and authorize the board chair to sign said contract as well as the engagement letter.

Hester, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Dan Brummitt, vote unanimous, to approve the contract with Carr, Riggs, & Ingram to perform the audit for fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 at a cost of \$47,000 and authorize the board chair to sign said contract as well as the engagement letter.
